CWC has in addition to monetarily, has raised awareness for and donated time and resources to the Wallingford Community Dinners, WPAA-TV Studio, Meriden Farmers Market, Meriden Park Opening Celebration and the Coalition for a Better Wallingford Open- Mic Music program.
